"The shortest distance between any two points on a golf course is a straight line that passes directly through the centre of a very large tree".

Heard over the fence – "When playing golf today, I hit two good balls. I stepped on a rake".

"The Golf Stroke"

A valid stroke is: a forward movement of the club at the players own ball made with the intention of hitting and moving the ball; but not including any swing voluntarily aborted. The backswing is not part of a valid stroke. Any infringements incurred in the backswing such as moving loose impediments in hazards, result in a penalty – 2 strokes. Strokes made other than "as defined" are not counted. An unintentional hit such as during a practice swing (at a ball in play) is not a valid stroke, nor is a swipe in anger. In both cases the stroke is not counted, but one stroke penalty is incurred and the ball is replaced.

The manner of striking the ball is also regulated. The ball must not be pushed or scooped and must be struck at with the head of the club (either front back or side) – Penalty 2 strokes.

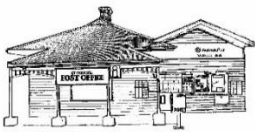

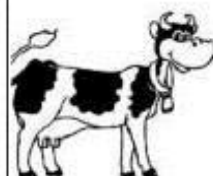

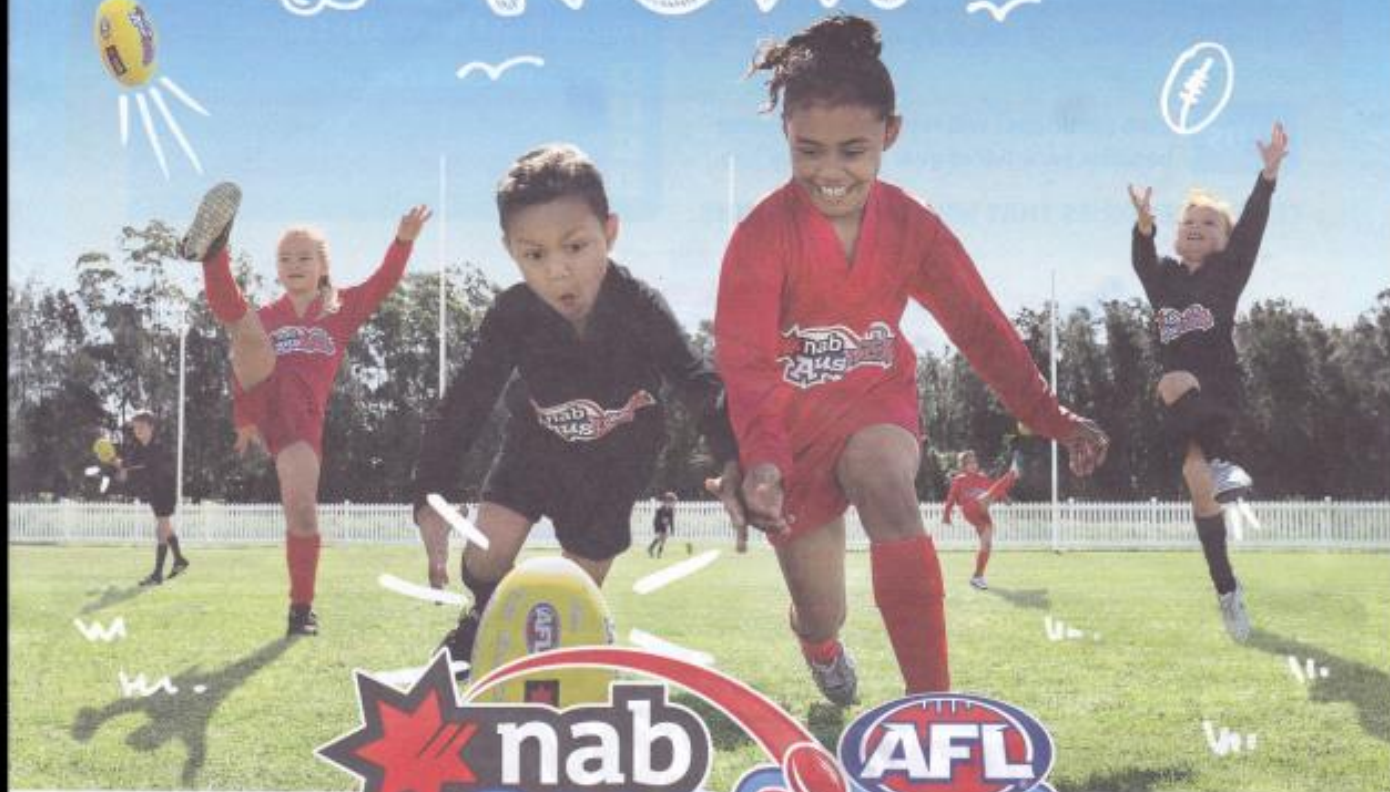
