### Port Welshpool Working Group

The Port Welshpool Working Group are a local community group that has been operating from the Old Ferry Terminal Building in Port Welshpool since 2003. The aims of the group are to support tourism and tourist activity, to maintain the Old Ferry Terminal as a community use building and to respond to issues raised by the community and work to have them resolved satisfactorily.

Our main function of the year is the Annual SeaDays Festival which will be held on the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> of January 2020. SeaDays is a family friendly festival that highlights environmental, marine ecology and cultural importance of the Corner Inlet area. The festival is run in co-operation with Parks Victoria's Summer by the Sea Program. Activities include coastal and marine life touch tanks, reptile display (Sunday only), displays of local organisations such as Coast Guard and historical talks at the Port Welshpool Maritime Museum. There are plenty of activities for all ages including boat and helicopter rides and the ever popular 'Come & Try Fishing Activity'.

In addition to the SeaDays Festival, the Port Welshpool Working Group runs a bimonthly indoor Market at the Ferry Terminal building. The next market will be held on Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> January 2020. The market is increasing in size and is a boost to the area.

The Old Ferry Terminal building is an excellent venue and is well used for private hire and public meetings. A Carpet Bowls social group uses the building weekly and the Port Welshpool Fishing Club calls it home. One of our favourite activities has been the designing and running of a 10 week / 1 term 'Learning to fish from the jetty' program for young people with disabilities in 2017 and 2018. This was as much fun for us as it was for the attendees.

The Port Welshpool Working Group has a small committee and some wonderful volunteers who respond to calls for assistance to do anything from cleaning, catering, selling raffle tickets or assisting with SeaDays or the indoor markets, but of course we would love to have more volunteers.
