



Port Welshpool & District Maritime Museum

Well here we are again... Santa's been and all is good. The Christmas school holidays have been and gone with lots of visitors to the Port. And along came the sand flies, of course, it wouldn't be summer without them. The Long Jetty is getting many visitors, no surprises there, what a view while you stroll along. The hotel is open for business and the General Store are run off their feet. Housing in the town is being bought and sold, some being demolished for more modern dwellings to take in the views. Sadly, the New Year started with the devastating bush fires. We look on with

amazement and disbelief that parts of our beautiful country could be reduced to this. As we help in whatever way we can, we hope that a lesson is learnt.

The New Year at the museum started with the Sea Days Festival.

Saturday began with early birds to the street stall; held under the veranda of the museum, they snapped up a bargain or found a novel from the Street Library A bit later in the day Local historian and author, Cheryl Glowery gave a talk on the Long Jetty's History. Much was learnt and many of those that attended contributed with their knowledge. Thanks Cheryl for your support.

On show was an extensive and interesting display of photos telling with interest the progress when Esso made Port Welshpool their depot for their oil exploration while Barry Beach was being developed. This is where the Long Jetty played another important part in history.

On Sunday, John Woolley a member of the museum and a seaman himself, with Esso, also had many stories to share as he gave an interesting talk about the long jetty and its involvement in setting up the oil exploration in Bass Strait. Many of the audience had worked at Barry Beach as it was being developed. The audience sharing knowledge which was widely received and helps keep history alive.

Reg McNee, Director, Offshore Specialists Ships, Australia was a member of the audience. John introduced Reg and invited him to speak of his knowledge of Esso and of Bass Strait oil exploration including the part Port Welshpool played.

While visitors enjoyed the relaxed and friendly atmosphere as they listened to the discussions, many asking questions or contributed to history, and later wandered around the museum to soak up more history, some looking for family in photos. Devonshire teas were also on demand from the cottage at the museum.

The museum committee are very pleased with the attendance, the interest shown and the history shared. Many conversations were followed up with photos shared.

Thanks to Reg McNee and Offshore & Specialists Ships Australia group; an offer has been made to the museum to hold an exhibition in the very near future. The committee jumped at the chance, as yet, dates are to be finalised but keep an eye out as all will be well advertised and a display not to be missed.




