The Long Jetty Restoration has begun

After countless years of campaigning and waiting, the wait is finally over. For those of you who have in recent weeks ventured down to Port Welshpool you will have seen that works on our iconic Long Jetty have started.

In a media release from the South Gippsland Shire Council, The Long Jetty Project Control Group (PCG) announced on July 24th that SMC Marine Pty Ltd had been awarded the contract by Gippsland Ports for the reconstruction.

"SMC Marine will rehabilitate the first 190m of the jetty. The section from 190m to 762m, the start of the burnt section, will be reconstructed. The concrete and steel deck will sit upon 188 new turpentine piles that will be driven on a rake to match the existing piles at six-metre intervals." (Media Release PR2075 24/7/17)

With works expected to take approximately 18 months, it is hoped that the Long Jetty will be completed by the end of 2018. This will be exciting not just for our locals but for the tourism industry of South Gippsland.

Many people young and old reminisce about their time spent walking and fishing from the Jetty. In the not too distant future this will be possible once again, and it is something many of us are looking forward to.

"The new jetty will be an impressive sight once completed and given the construction methods it should be an impressive sight for decades to come." (South Gippsland Shire Major, Cr Ray Argento)

PROVISIONAL BALL

A provisional ball may be played, if it is considered that the ball played may be out of bounds or may be lost, outside of a water hazard.

A provisional ball cannot be played if:

- 1. The ball played is definitely in a water hazard, or
- 2. The player has gone forward to search for the ball

It is not possible to "go back" to play a provisional ball. The point at which the original ball becomes "out of play" is when a stroke is made at another ball or the five minute search time has elapsed.


