People come from all over Gippsland to get a bargain or that rare piece of furniture. Of course thanks to all the people of Welshpool and the surrounding districts for supporting and donating their previously loved items. The Welshpool and District Advisory Group which represent you, the community, now own both the Rural Transaction Centre and the Op Shop building which have a total value of over \$200,000.





# Port Welshpool & District Maritime Museum

Hunter Gathering.. Firstly, remember going out to gather firewood. This was a family outing and how we kids just loved it. All was needed to keep the home warm, the copper light for our Sunday night bath, the washing done on Mondays, and the great meals mum cooked up on the wood stove. The dads and the older boys worked on the saws and axes. Not only were the boys cutting the wood but also learning the responsibility and how to use important sharp tools. Whilst the girls collected what firewood they could carry to load up the boot of the car or maybe you were lucky enough to own a trailer. Telegraph Road was a popular spot for collecting wood, as all were taught, what was the best wood to burn, what was dry and what was green. While we were having fun doing all this, a kangaroo or echidna may be disturbed. Then there were always the wild flowers or the little birds darting around chirping loudly, maybe warning us we were invading their homes, all the thrill of the bush and how lucky were we to experience it all.

Mushrooming.. Love them or hate them, it was fun collecting them. Armed with a knife and a bucket, out we set. Remember the thrill and the excitement when the first mushroom was spotted. Tap it on the top, (I was never sure as a kid why we did this, maybe to make sure no fairies were home), and then cut it through the stalk with the knife. Once again not only were we collecting food but being taught how to manage a knife while running around madly collecting as many mushrooms as we could, as the one with the most in their bucket wins.

Collecting blackberries..Now you may not like mushrooms but you must love blackberries. Even though collecting was a tad challenging. All those thorns to dodge, as it was quite a task getting them out if you were unlucky enough to get one in your finger as we usually did. You could always wear gloves, but no, we were tough, we could cope. Usually we ate more than we put in the bucket. It didn't matter, there were plenty for mum to make jam or that yum blackberry pie. Apart from the thorns the only critter to be mindful of were snakes, but usually they stayed out of the way. You may frighten a rabbit that was having a bit of quiet time in his burrow, but he could always come back when we were gone.

How lucky were we to experience all this fun in the bush and take the great memories into adulthood to share along the way.






