## SPEEDY MINESTRONE SOUP.

### Ingredients:

- |                                 |   |
|---------------------------------|---|
| 1 TBS olive oil                 | 2 cups tomato pasta sauce (bottled)     |
| 1 med. onion, thinly sliced     | 300g can butter beans, rinsed & drained |
| 1 clove garlic, crushed         | 3 cups chicken stock                    |
| 2 bacon rashers, chopped        | 1 cup shredded cabbage                  |
| 2 sticks celery, chopped        | ¼ cup macaroni                          |
| 1 med. carrot, chopped          | ¼ cup shaved parmesan cheese, fresh     |
| 1 lge. potato, peeled & chopped |   |

### Method;

Heat oil in a large pan, add onion, garlic and bacon. Stir until the onion is soft. Add celery, carrot and potato, cook stirring for 2 minutes. Stir in tomato sauce, beans, stock, cabbage and macaroni. Bring to the boil and simmer, covered, for 30 minutes. Serve sprinkled with cheese.







### *THINGS TO DO IN MAY*
