SPEEDY MINESTRONE SOUP.

Ingredients:

- 1 TBS olive oil
- 1 med. onion, thinly sliced
- 1 clove garlic, crushed
- 2 bacon rashers, chopped
- 2 sticks celery, chopped 1 med. carrot, chopped
- 1 lge. potato, peeled & chopped
- 2 cups tomato pasta sauce (bottled)
- 300g can butter beans, rinsed & drained
- 3 cups chicken stock
- 1 cup shredded cabbage
- ¼ cup macaroni
- 1/4 cup shaved parmesan cheese, fresh



Method;

Heat oil in a large pan, add onion, garlic and bacon. Stir until the onion is soft. Add celery, carrot and potato, cook stirring for 2 minutes. Stir in tomato sauce, beans, stock, cabbage and macaroni. Bring to the boil and simmer, covered, for 30 minutes. Serve sprinkled with cheese.

THINGS TO DO IN MAY

- Collect fallen leaves and add to your compost
- Perennials need to be pruned now before winter sets in
- Feed bulbs as their new growth emerges
- Ease off watering indoor plants. Too much water will lead to browning tips. Let pots dry out completely before watering.



Register your burn All burn-offs should be registered with ESTA on 1800 668 511 Check fire restrictions and fire danger ratings. Check local laws in regards to when & where you can burn off. Notify your neighbours. Never leave your burn unattended. Monitor weather conditions. Access to adequate water, at least 10 litres.
