
Sundays – Pappy Pope and Ladies on Wednesdays – Trish Latch and Fran MacPherson



TRAINS....What happened to our train?

As we travelled through the countryside by car, the toot, toot of the whistle as the train approached the level crossing and the puff of smoke in the distance was a comforting sight of communication. Not only was it a means of travel so we could visit our city cousins but it also brought them to us.

The long journey was all part of the excitement as you caught the train bound for Yarram. It left the platform at Flinders Street at a few minutes past 6pm. You knew it was a long hall to Welshpool but that didn't matter, you were on your way home away from the rat race of the city and back to the green, green grass of Gippsland. How does it go? "You can take the girl out of the country but you can't take the country out of the girl". At around midnight, the train pulled into the Welshpool station. Not a light to be seen, you peered through the darkness in hope that your family had remembered and not slept in. The only light was the guard in the guards van signalling to the driver all was clear to head to Hedley Station.

The "Red Rattler" as it was fondly known was not only our means of transport but it was also our source of deliveries. The mail and parcels all made the journey in the guards van along with the guard. The man with the red flag and whistle signalling to the driver all was clear to head for the next station.

As you settled in for the long journey counting every stop until you reached Korumburra. I loved this station as not only was it a refreshment stop, but, what a pride this station was. The long counter of polished wood and the welcoming smell of pies and coffee as you raced in to be served. The ladies behind the counter, all in the ready, dressed in their crisp white uniforms, buzzing around with pride and efficiency, all against the clock to get each traveller back on the train as there was a deadline to meet.

On the mourning journey back to Melbourne, cold frosty mornings come to mind. You entered the train, put your luggage in the racks and then off you went to find the hottest foot warmer.

Hoping there weren't many passengers making the journey, and there usually wasn't. There you settled in for the long journey hoping you had the carriage to yourself. With a toilet on board and water fountain to quench your thirst if needed you sat back on the leather seats and enjoyed what the carriage had to offer. Great views of the countryside as you gazed out the window.

In the carriage you were surrounded by Photos of other country areas, usually history gone by, along with some advertising just in case you were tempted to use Vic rail to seek another destination. At 12noon the train pulled into Flinders Street Station, here I was back in the rat race until I could do it all again.

No graffiti or slashed seats. Clean as a whistle, the pride of the tracks.




