- 1 cup (128 grams) yellow onion, chopped
- 1 ½ cups (212 grams) carrots, diced
- ½ cup (60 grams) 2 celery stalks, chopped
- 2 garlic cloves, peeled and grated or finely chopped
- 1 teaspoon fresh rosemary, finely chopped
- 1 ½ cups (140 grams) zucchini, diced
- ½ cup (40 grams) butternut squash, diced
- 1 cup (80 grams) sweet potatoes, diced
- 15 ounces (425 grams) passata or crushed tomatoes
- 3 ½ cups (826 ml) beef stock, or vegetable stock if you prefer
- ¼ teaspoon freshly ground black pepper
- Parmesan cheese rind
- Salt to taste, if needed
- 15 ounces (425 grams) cannellini beans
- ½ cup (100 grams) small pasta, cooked

Method:



- 2. Add the zucchini, squash, potatoes and passata.
- 3. Add the beef stock, pepper and Parmesan rind. Bring to a simmer and cook for 20 minutes slightly covered, or until the potatoes are tender.
- 4. Taste for seasoning, add salt if needed (the rind will also add salt). Remove the Parmesan rind, stir in the beans and pasta.
- 5. Serve hot with freshly grated Parmesan cheese.
