

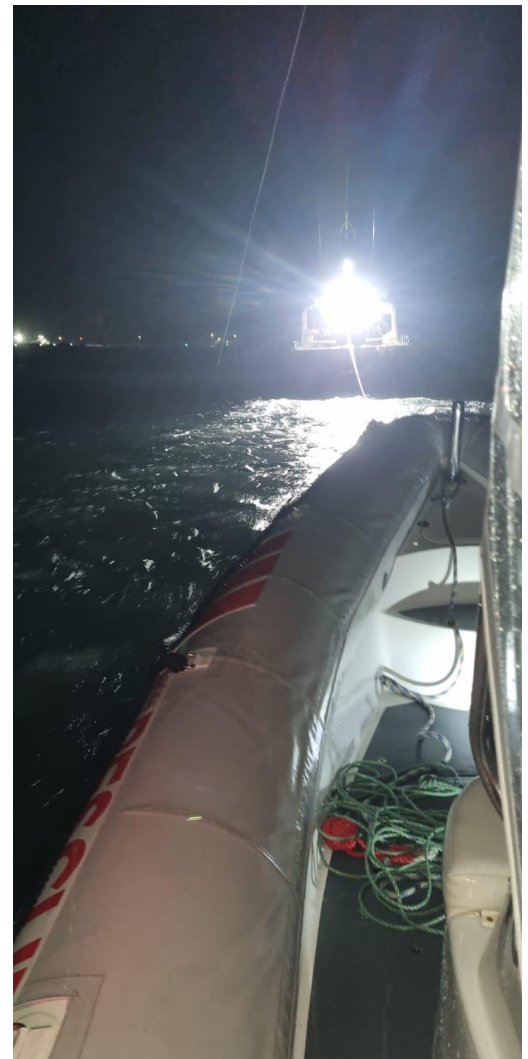


Port Welshpool Coast Guard

Port Welshpool Coastguard recently conducted night operations training (in conjunction with Coast Guard Port Albert), allowing one member from each flotilla to be signed off as a fully-fledged skipper, and giving other crew members valuable experience working onboard at night and establishing a tow. The fact it was raining just further exacerbated the restricted visibility conditions, but real-life responses aren't always in perfect weather. So, training in poor weather just further improves our skills and competency to effect safe and efficient responses. As the Australian Volunteer Coast Guard motto says, 'Safety By All Means'.

PORT WELSHPOOL & DISTRICT MARITIME MUSEUM

This first article is from the Archive: Tells of the forming of the Welshpool Football Club into the Association. You will notice as you read the interesting wording. It was known then as the "Shire Association". At the Museum we have a lot of history of this club as it progressed through the years on its own until; to stay playing, it had to amalgamate with clubs that were once its rivals. The club had a few changes of colours over its life all on show at the Museum and I wonder was Masons coffee palace in Welshpool and where?

The Argus April 14th April 1914

A meeting was held at Mason's coffee palace on Friday last for the purpose of forming a local football club. Mr D. Edwards was appointed to the chair, and there was a large attendance of football enthusiasts present. It was decided to form a club, and the following officers were appointed:— President, Mr W. B. M. Smith; vice-presidents, Messrs F. Tindale and M. G. Ormsby ; secretary, Mr D. Edwards; treasurer, Mr S. Mason ; general committee, Messrs A. Rackstraw, M. McAuliffe, H. Kerr, T. Crouch, L. Shiells, A. Sinnbeck, Les Kerr. It was resolved to stick to the old colours—red and white—and on the motion of Messrs Daff and Merritt to join the shire association. The president and secretary were appointed delegates, and member's tickets were fixed at 3/~, Ladies 1/6.

The school picnic to Snake Island

On April 4th proved a great success. The weather was all that could be desired and about 200 children and parents from Welshpool, Hedley and Woorarra took advantage of the occasion and spent an enjoyable day. Mr. A. Miller and Sons and Mr Bruce Smith, assisted by Mr. N Outwin, were good enough to provide motor boats to convey the picnickers to and from the island and for whom three cheers were given. Races and Games were the order of the day, the married ladies and old buffers races proving the most exciting, each having about a dozen competitors. The first was won by Mr R Ferguson with Mrs McCarthy a close second. Mr A. Christenson and Mr Neil Hiho were first and second in the old buffers.

Owing to the boisterous weather conditions prevailing on Monday, the Port Welshpool Tennis Club motorboat picnic across corner inlet had to be postponed. The promoters now announce that the event will take place on Saturday 2nd May and that 20 motorboats have been commissioned to convey the picnickers to the trysting place. Trams from Welshpool will run at intervals and hot water will be provided free for those who patronise the outing.

I hope you enjoyed reading these articles as we look back through the ages and compare the different way of life, we have now, "Free Hot Water", no thermos, food vans for events. The surnames are a lasting reminder of the families that helped developed this area. The schools that have amalgamate. The Tennis Club no longer formed, but the courts still stand proudly with all their hidden history. The boat owned by Bruce Smith mentioned in the school picnic article is still afloat and is moored in the Paynesville harbour.

The club played in the Alberton Shire Association in 1926 with other clubs being Alberton, Devon, Foster, Toora, Ramblers, Won Wron, Woodside and Yarram.

Final Four consisted of Devon, Yarram, Won Wron and Toora.

Devon were premiers by defeating Toora in the Grand Final.

Food Organics and Garden Organics (FOGO) Service




The Victorian Government is standardising household waste and recycling across the state under the new *Circular Economy (Waste Reduction and Recycling) Act 2021*.

So, from 1 July 2026, Council is introducing a FOGO kerbside collection service.

Here is a summary of what is changing from 1 July:

- Food scraps will go in your green lidded FOGO bin with your garden clippings to become high-quality compost.
- FOGO bin will be collected weekly.
- General waste bin (red lid) will be collected fortnightly.

Your kerbside collection will look like this:

Bin Type	Material	Volume and Frequency
 FOGO (Green lid)	Food organics. Garden organics.	240 litre. Weekly collection.
 Recycling (Yellow lid)	Mixed recycling (cardboard, hard plastic etc.)	240 litre. Fortnightly collection.
 General Waste (Red lid)	Waste that is not recyclable or compostable.	120 litre. Fortnightly collection.

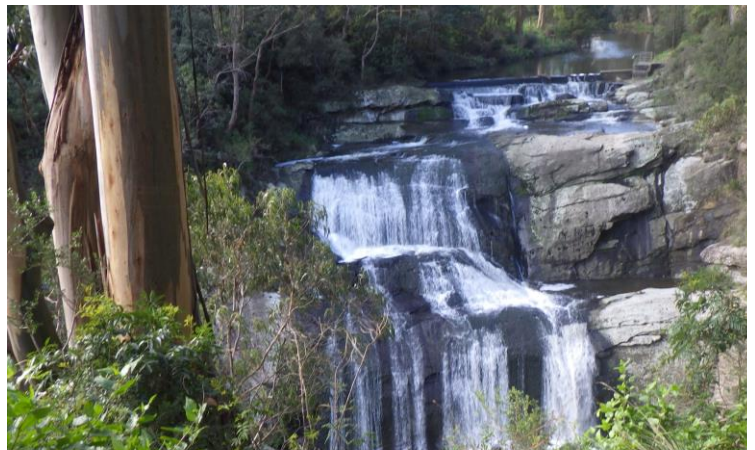

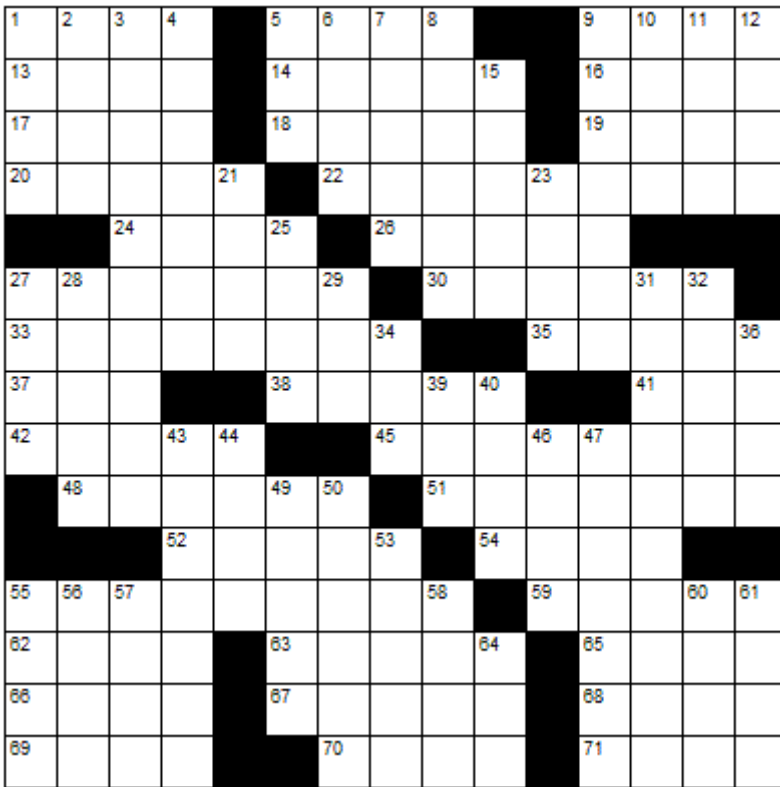

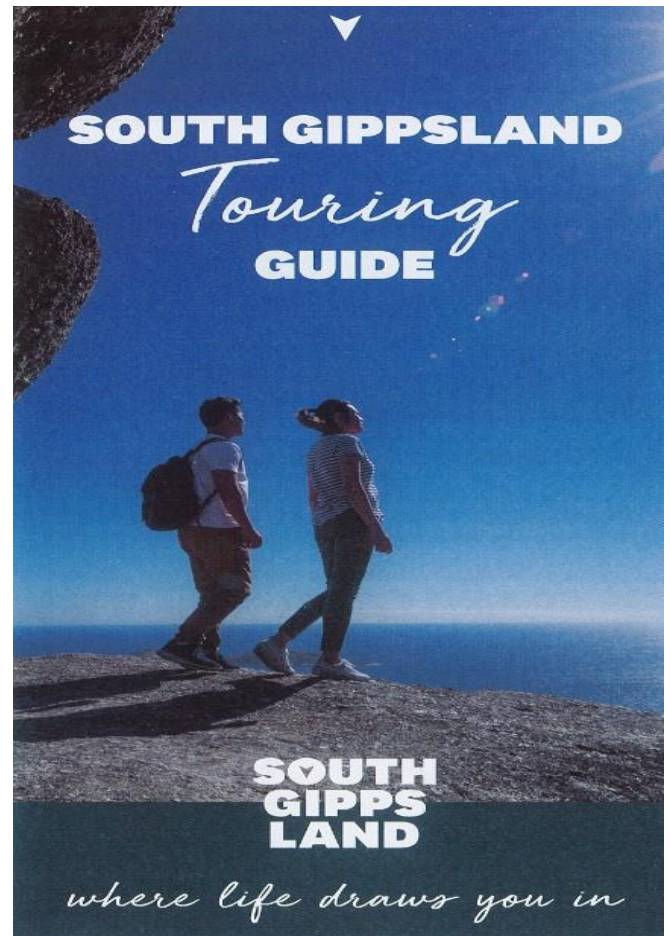

Share Your Thoughts on the Draft 2026/27 Budget

The Draft 2026/27 Budget is now available for community feedback.

Council began preparing this budget early, with community engagement taking place at the very start of the process in late 2025. This early consultation gave South Gippsland residents the opportunity to help shape projects from the outset.

Unfortunately, due to events on the other side of the world, costs have risen dramatically in recent weeks, particularly the cost of fuel, and this has put pressure on Council's operating environment and the cost of delivering core services and current infrastructure projects.

As a result, Council has made the decision to reframe the Budget, limiting spending on new initiatives to focus on maintaining the services our community relies on. This more conservative approach will allow us to deliver key

projects while protecting Council's long-term financial sustainability.

The budget provides funding for meaningful outcomes, including:

- A \$24 million capital works program to progress important renewal projects.
- The first stage of the Region Precincts and Partnerships Program, a \$4.7 million Australian Government-funded initiative being delivered in partnership with Wellington Shire Council.
- Economic Development and Visitor Economy Strategy, to be delivered in-house to achieve cost savings.
