If you are out fishing, don't throw your old tackle overboard, save it and place into the special collection box at the boat ramp when you return.

PWWG volunteers will empty the box periodically and collate the amount of tackle recovered.

It is hoped if this is successful, further collection boxes will be installed at the end of the Long Jetty and Fisherman's Wharf.

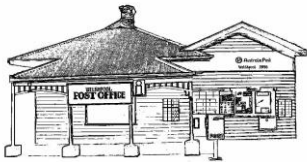

Welshpool Area Future Focus Group

The Welshpool Area Future Focus Group (WAFF Group) have been busy in the last month or so finalising the new community plan which will be available to view at the Welshpool Rural Transaction Centre very soon. The WAFF Group have taken everyone's ideas into consideration and created a plan that includes all ideas, with some being prioritised according to community feedback.

The group have already started working on a number of the suggestions, including the community garden in Welshpool, replacing the rotunda in the Welshpool Park, Welcome Packs to new residents to the area, free WiFi in town, and inquires have been made regarding more seating along the Port Welshpool foreshore and we have raised attention to the state of the sea wall at Port Welshpool with the local paper.

The Community garden in Welshpool has had its first win by the members of the Welshpool and District Advisory Group committee offering the yard at the rear of the Welshpool Op Shop as a space for the garden. This is great news as the first step of finding a destination can be one of the trickiest. Members of the Waff Group have since met with Josh from the Corner Inlet Landcare Group who has assisted us with an overall garden plan and made some suggestions to help with the layout.

These as well as a number of ideas on the plan are not quick overnight tasks and will take some time to implement, however we want to ensure the community that we are a very proactive group who are keen to see some improvements to our beautiful part of the world. THE TENNIS COURT.

The photo below of the Tennis Court as it was many years ago. This court still takes pride of place in Dawson Street just off Turnbull Street. It has seen many changes during its life. Once a community hall kept it company, but due to the hall catching fire, it is said, due to old wiring causing electrical fault in the meter box and as you can see in the photos it wasn't burnt to the ground but for whatever reason, sadly it was never rebuilt. Over the hall's life it witnessed many celebrations including 2 world wars. Church was also held there due to the Port never having a Church building. Prep grades for school were held there for many years along with end of school Christmas parties. The community used it for many club occasions including meetings, dances, and card nights, send offs and milestone birthdays. Originally the hall was able to be built because the town's people knew there was a need and of the times every town had a hall, so with 3 property owners going guarantors the sum of 1757 pounds was lent and Mr. H. Hull did the building.

For the opening night the piano from the now Museum was lent for the occasion, being taken to the hall by horse drawn tram.

For many years this Tennis Court has stood out of site hoping someone would hear its cry for attention as it slowly deteriorated due to non-use and the weather elements. SO.....with great thanks to volunteers of the community and a few handy dollars the Tennis Court has had a makeover and stands ready for players with balls and rackets there for you to borrow. No keys needed. The original umpires chair stands proudly with its P.W.T.C. logo. This chair has stood the test of time and seen many changes come and go around it and now I'm sure happy for the company of people of all ages enjoying a game of tennis as many did in the past when there was a competitive club, that held its own in the area.

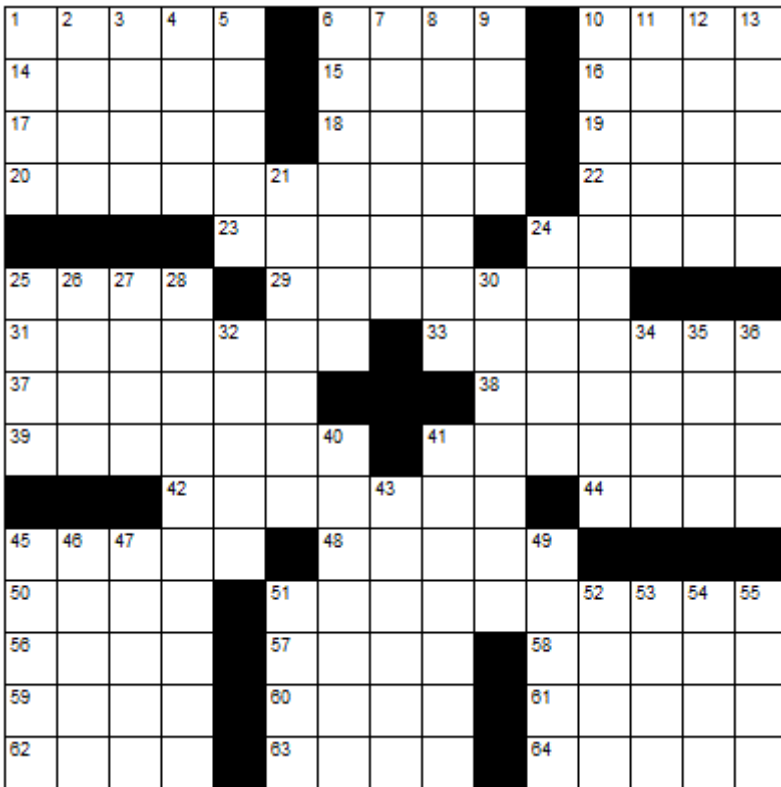

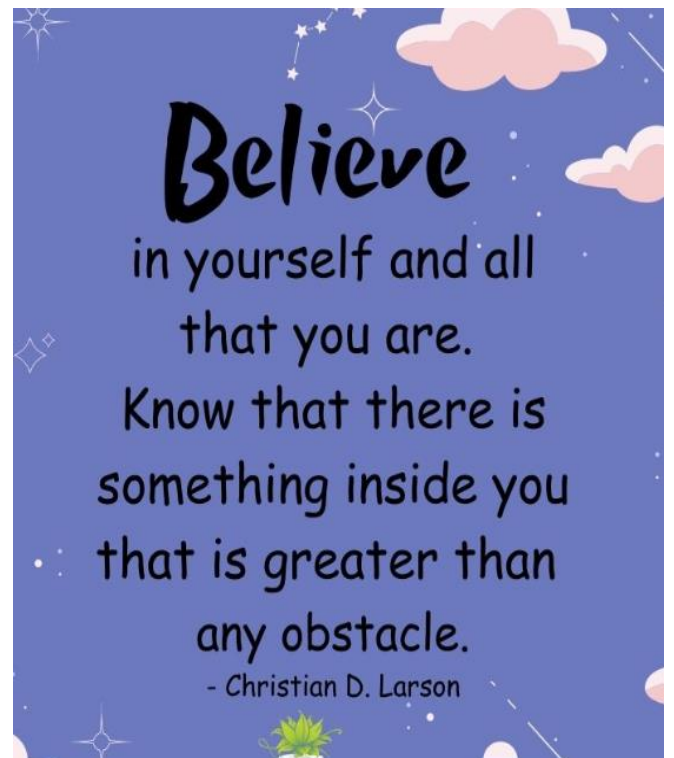

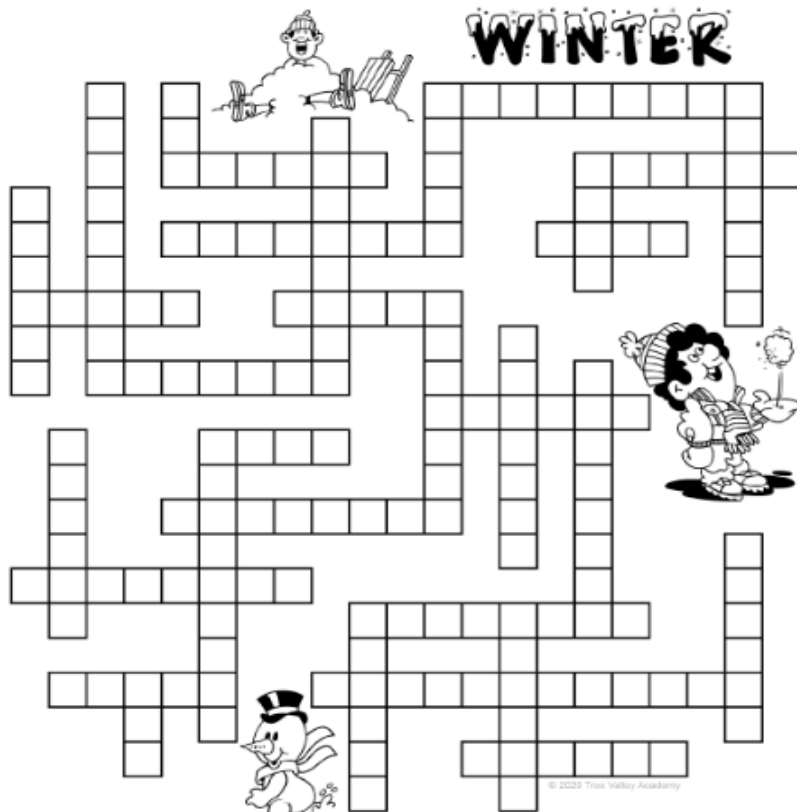
