Christmas Cornflake Wreath Cookies

Ingredients

- waxed paper
- ½ cup butter
- 4 cups miniature marshmallows
- 1 teaspoon green food colouring, or as needed
- ½ teaspoon almond extract
- ½ teaspoon vanilla extract
- 4 cups cornflakes cereal
- 1 pack of M&M's



Directions

1. Gather all ingredients.
2. Line a baking tray with waxed paper.
3. Place marshmallows and butter in a microwave-safe bowl; microwave on high for 2 minutes. Stir, then microwave on high for 2 minutes more; stir.
4. Mix in colouring, almond extract, and vanilla until the desired colour is reached; gently stir in cornflakes to coat.
5. Drop by tablespoonful's onto the prepared tray and use lightly greased fingers to form wreath shapes; decorate with 3 M&M's.
6. Allow cookies to cool and set, about 15 minutes; store in an airtight container.

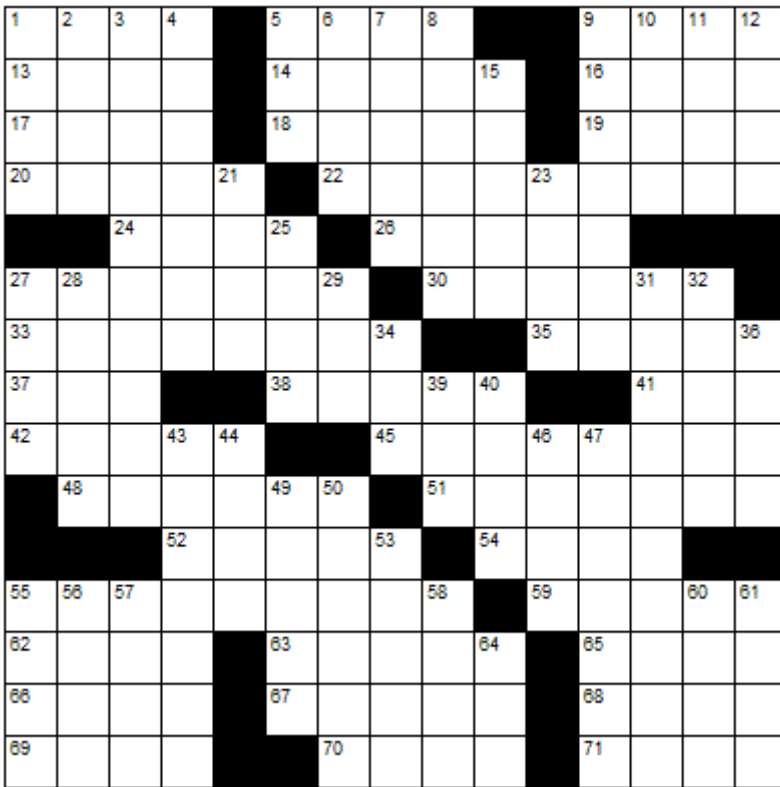

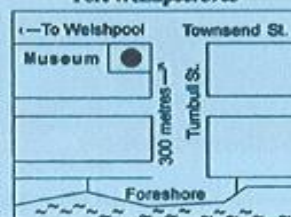

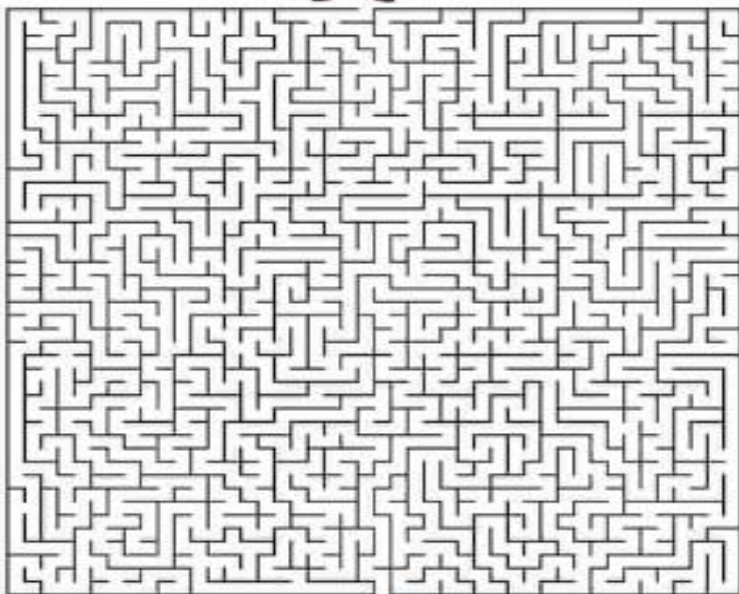
