



Council has initiated a green and food waste amnesty until Tuesday 27 February.

Green waste and spoiled goods can be disposed of at all South Gippsland transfer stations.

Transfer stations are open according to <u>regular operating hours</u> except for Mirboo North which is open daily, including weekends, from 9.00am to 4.00pm.

There is no limitation on branch size but weed restrictions still apply.

- Commercial contractors can also drop off green waste for free with no limitations on the size of trucks.
- Skip bins are also in place to help with the discarding of food waste only, in the following locations:
 - Mirboo North located opposite the Hall (toilet car park).
 - Meeniyan (rear of shops).




The men's winners were Russell and Billy on 42pts beating Paul and Pappy with 41pts.

We will also soon be putting together Welcome Packs for newcomers to the area with relevant information of services available to help welcome them to the area.

Information is being sourced on the possibility of free Wi-Fi in the township of Welshpool.

A number of members of our group as well as community members attended the "Community Catch up" in Port Welshpool on the 24th January. Here we met with three councillors and discussions were held regarding many issues around the area. Many notes were taken and hopefully some positive comes out of the meeting. The Welshpool Area Future Focus Group will be following up with council on a number of items that were raised at the meeting to move forward on some of the issues that have existed for some time.

You will also see some new bins around Welshpool and Port Welshpool. These are a welcome site

from the previous plastic bins. We have noted that a couple of them were not replaced and we have raised this with council. We have also asked about having a couple of extra bins down at the jetty and boat ramp and also at the Welshpool Park to help accommodate the busy weekend traffic.




