South Gippsland landholders have been enjoying borrowing our camera trap kits and finding out which wildlife and pest animals are present on their properties. Some surprises have included lyrebirds in areas where they weren't expected to be found, koalas, a range of birds, and of course lots of wallabies, kangaroos and wombats. Refrigeration:

With Mother Nature at the helm, the recent storm in the area creating trees to lose limbs and take power lines with them. With lightening creating havoc putting everyone into survival mode and a very important concern was to save many dollars of food from the garbage as life took on a different meaning without power. Even though tolerance was well experienced after the recent floods, it's times like these that living on your own can be very worrying. But with resilience of the community all were cared for. We shop each week for the essentials and always popping in the trolley that bit extra, to take advantage while it is on special, or the extra bit of a meal left over put in the freezer, for when cooking is too hard to face.

As we look back to the 1890's when the father of refrigeration became the Holy Grail for the preservation of food. Namely "The Coolgardie Safe"; the once must have, invented in the late 1890's; is credited to Arthur Patrick McCormick on the Gold Fields of Coolgardie, W.A. The safe used evaporation to keep the food inside cool while protecting it from flies. It consists of a frame of wood or metal covered with hessian fabric. On the top of the cabinet a tank filled with water and strips of felt hanging down the sides of the hessian creating a "wicking" action by water dripped onto the hessian keeping it damp. As the breeze evaporated the water from the fabric it absorbed the heat from the surrounding air and kept the contents cool. Seen hanging in trees sheltered from the sun, taking advantage of a light breeze. As electricity was not needed all was "safe"!! Over the centuries progress was made with the invention of different materials and as we jump forward to the present day fridges, you can smile at how far we have come. And thank goodness we have. Our present day choice of fridges with different compartments or the upside-down fridge to save the back and not to mention the ice maker with its own supply of water. There's even a lockable section to keep medicines. We have progressed from having the choice of the stark white, to any colour to match your kitchen plus the choice of many sizes. Remember when the fridge was proudly passed down from generation to generation and even when it got too ugly for the kitchen it became the beer /drinks fridge in the shed. Or when it said enough is enough it became storage for chook food as no mouse in the district that could break and enter this pantry. We mustn't forget the ice chest, as a cousin to the Coolgardie Safe. How lucky are we to have experienced all these inventions as it puts a smile on your face for the memories good and bad to go with the times. Imagine a Coolgardie Safe hanging in a tree these days to keep all that is a must have safe or even one fridge per household with its tiny freezer compartment.
