



#### The Washing Machine

As daylight saving has ended and the days become darker and colder, we take cover as winter clouds our days. In days gone by, this meant the wood pile was to be checked as much wood was needed to keep the home fires burning. Not only was there the open fire that we lovingly sat around and where our clothes hung on the clothes horse to dry but the wood for the stove for cooking was another demand on the wood pile. For another all-year rounder putting demands on the wood pile was the copper and wood to heat the water for the Sunday night bath, how times have changed in this regard. The wood for the combustion stove also heating the water was a welcome invention and is still in us in a few homes today in a more modern style. Monday was the popular day to see the clothes flapping in the wind. Not like today where we have a pile or not and with a press of a button all is done.

Once it took mum most of the day to complete her day in the wash house as she slaved over the troves to wash, rinse, or starch our clothes for the week and of course it didn't finish there the ironing was to be tackled. Looking back the stove too het up the iron.

Today we have everything at our fingertips. The choices when buying a modern day washing machines are endless. Firstly, it's front or top loader. With front loader, don't forget an article!! Clothes in need of a bit of extra TLC were always soaked in a bucket or trough; now you can have a soaking dish built into some top loading machines. From the copper to the trough through the mangle, rinsed, and back through the mangle then out to the line was the way. It was hard work for mum. Now.... There are a few very important decisions to make before the clothes even get wet; Soaking or washing? water temperature, plus what size load? cycle for the type of fabrics. The time it takes to go through a cycle on my front loader its forever; but what does it matter really? For it's just set and forget and walk away. Just hope the weather holds out!! Like most white goods these days they have the need to talk to you. With the fridge; it's to let you know you have left the door open, which isn't a bad one but having a washing machine telling you it has finished by playing a programmed tune so you know it has happily completed the task you set it and is ready for the next, who would have every have thought. Life of a washing machine has also changed. If you could afford to buy one when you got married, it lasted you for life or if not there was the pass me down which you were most grateful for and it too lasted through the Mondays. And let us not forget the very important part of this process was the washing powder. The jingles sang to us as they boasted they had the answer to our wash day prays by giving us the Whitest of Whites with "Persil" or "Omo" would give us the Brightest of Bright. Remember Blueo? Not only did it help whiten your whites but was the go to for a bull ant bite. As your clothes hung on the line, proudly secured with dolly pegs, and proudly showing off your hard work for all passing by to see; on a line strung from tree to tree and held up by a forked tree branch.

Velvet soap was another well used product especially when hand washing those delicate pieces. I mentioned the pegs; well there's a story for maybe another time.






