Once again Welshpool was treated to an incredible display of beauty at this year's "Spring Fantasy" Show, held on Friday 3rd and Saturday 4th November.








LOOKING BACK THROUGH THE AGES:

Recently the Museum was contacted by Pat Webb a 91 year old lady, who is a great Aunt of one of the first to teach at Port Welshpool State School 3375. Her name was Miss Elsie Cornell; she taught at the school in the very early 1900's. The reason we were contacted, while Pat was having a Spring clean she found 2 books that had been presented to Miss Cornell on her leaving Port Welshpool. Pat contact the Museum to ask if we would be interested in having them, and we are thrilled.

Two houses still stand proudly today in Townsend Street that were once part of the education system; one where Miss Cornell taught and the other across the road in later years was the head masters house, in early years there was only one teacher, one room to teach all grades. If anyone can help with stories or photos we would love to hear from you.

As the school year slowly comes to an end and children take the next step in their lives, whether it be starting school, or stepping up into Secondary College or maybe school is over and it's off to a career but whatever the plan we wish you all the very best and enjoy your break before the next chapter of life starts.

SCHOOL HOLIDAYS BACK WHEN WE WERE KIDS:

How we loved this time. Life was a big adventure.

We woke of a morning, fun at our disposal. Maybe we had a few chores to do, but they wouldn't take long, as we had better things in mind. Just the same we needed to keep mum sweet, as we planned our fun for the day, in our minds. With the chores done, off we set to meet our pals. Trust and responsibility at our planning, and, just in case, if it went "a little bit wrong," we would always learn from our mistakes, probably with a good talking too. OR the dreaded strap.

This story from our archives. I felt it said a lot about childhood and the adventures we shared with our pals. In this case you can imagine the despair of the parents to say the least, but experience is a great tool. These kids didn't need an EPERB, or mobile phone, no, just take cover and wait.

ARGUS [Melbourne]. MISSING BOYS FOUND ON SNAKE ISLAND. Tuesday 29th. November 1938 As it reads; After they had spent the night on Snake Island near Port Welshpool five boys were found safe yesterday. Four men had searched anxiously all night for the boys who had left Port Welshpool in a dinghy on Sunday.

The boys were William Dobbs, aged 14, Frank Roberts 13 his brother Robert 10, Alan Olsen 11, and brother Clarrie 9. The boys rowed to Snake Island on Sunday afternoon, and then waded across the channel to Big Snake Island. When they prepared to return they found that the tide had risen and they could not reach the dinghy. They spent the night in a cattlemen's hut where they were found by Mr. Ferlazzo. WELL...maybe this adventure went "a little bit wrong", But hey....... this adventure was an experience of childhood and living; thankfully,

"all's well that ends well."






