# The Port Welshpool & District Maritime Museum

As we go through the year we are rewarded with public holidays and Mother Nature gives us some mild weather to explore our surrounds. The car park at the boat ramp fill to overflowing and into Lewis Street on occasions with excited and enthusiastic boat goers; some for the first time with their new pride and joy, others are old hands. Big, small, old and new boats all on their way to catch their dream and to soak in the sea air and the wonders of Corner Inlet and Bass Strait framed by Wilsons Promontory. Bass Strait's weather can be very unpredictable and can change in an instant with the change of the tide, therefore unprepared can be caught unaware but now with the Coast Guard only a phone call away, lives are saved.

Port Welshpool has always been a haven for fishermen who travel from near and far and now many have taken up ownership of holiday houses to fulfil a dream of retired living to the waters and weather they have learnt to respect. If you have a tolerance for the wind and sand fly's, relaxation is at your fingertips. Many more own a boat these days; but in days gone by, as it was the way to book a boat; taking out a "fishing party" for a day's fishing and during this outing; weather and tide being right; landing on the Prom for a picnic lunch was a great treat. Your experience was in the hands of an experienced boat owner who knew the fishing grounds and mostly supplied everything from lines to bait. At a pound ahead it was great value.

This well-known fishing Port hasn't always been for those who choose to come and go over a weekend. Once, the little jetty was the home of a large fleet of boats of all sizes including Crayfish and Shark boats. When crayfish were 66c a kilo; yes, I know hard to believe when you compare today's prices. If you were lucky enough to be down the jetty when the Cray's were being bagged for Ryan's Transport to take to market, a Cray could be tossed onto the jetty for you to take home. These were dead crays and would not sell at market, as buyers only were attracted to crayfish that were flapping as they were tipped down the ramp to waiting shop owners to buy at the Footscray Market.

A present day walk down the fishermen's jetty, as it is now called, we see the pleasure crafts moored, waiting for a group to take on a sightseeing cruise, your mind is cast back and the question is, I wonder what happened to the fleet that we were so familiar with? Namely, Valda S, Plover, Mary Norling, William Flair, Halloween, William Norling, Patricia, Francis May, Alida R, Whodunit just to remember a few. Time moves on while history collects and some of the experiences that were witnessed over the years are only memories; when families relied on the catch that each of this great fleet came back to Port with to pay the bills after spending sometimes weeks at sea with the only connection with family was the ship to shore radio. Back when we ate fish of all kinds all year, and a roast at Christmas was special.






