



Port Welshpool Community Plan Update

Earlier this year the Port Welshpool Working Group, after consultation with the local community, identified four projects that were seen as important for Port Welshpool.

A vote was then taken to prioritize these projects.

A total of 78 valid votes were received, a great result for a small town like Port Welshpool.

The results are:

- Footpath crossings from Lewis Street to the fore shore walking track......216 votes.
- Public toilets at the Long Jetty......210 votes.
- Street Light upgrades......185 votes.
- Seating upgrade along the Lewis Street Foreshore......169 votes.

Sophie Dixon at the South Gippsland Shire Council has reported that planning is underway regarding the Footpath crossings (Keene, Albert and Stratton Streets).

The Port Welshpool Working Group will work with Council and other relevant bodies to implement the remaining projects.

We will endeavor to keep you informed of progress with these projects.

The Port Welshpool Working Group would like to thank all the residents that took the time to fill out the voting forms.
