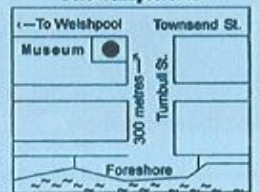

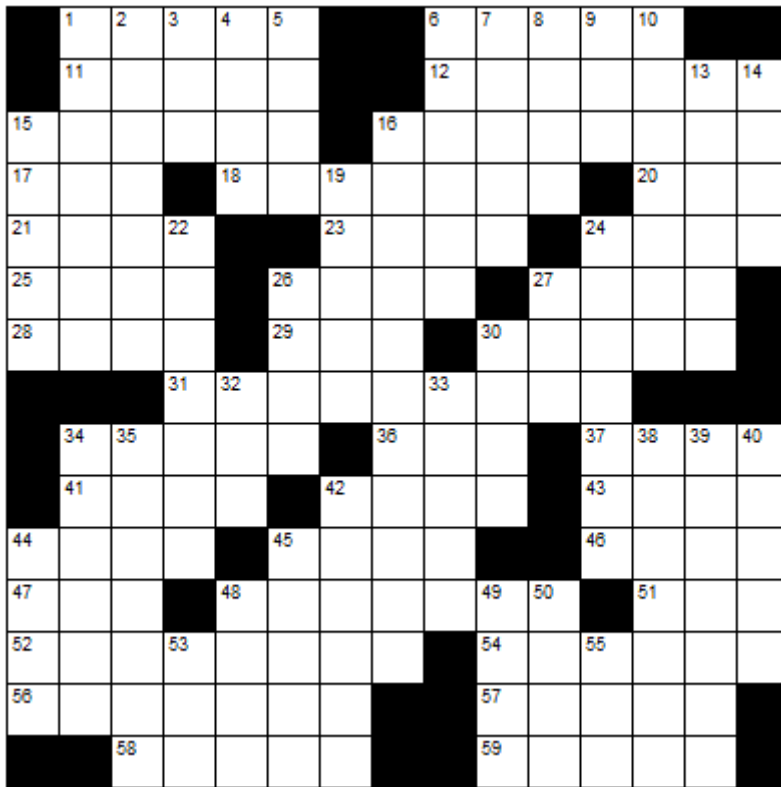

Port Welshpool & District Bowling Club

This month our club awarded Trevor Vening with Life Membership.

Trevor is the longest serving members of the Port Welshpool and District Bowling Club having joined the club in 1992/93 and has been the President for the past 2 seasons.

Over his time, he has served as Bar Manager, Saturday Pennant Team Manager, Pennant Selector and, like so many of this club's members, volunteer when jobs and projects are needing to be done.

Trevor took out his first club title with the Pairs in 1993/94 alongside Ken McPhail and again in 1995/96 with Brian Platt, 2000/01 with Andy Clark and 2005/06 with Neil Gore.

He has also taken out 3 Mixed Pairs titles with Joy Craig in 1998/99 and 1999/2000 and with Margaret McDonald in 2005/06.

After 30 years in 2022/23, Trevor finally took out his first Men's Club Championship and then went on to claim back-to-back titles in 2023/24.

Trevor first tasted Pennant success in the back-to-back Saturday Premiership teams in 1996/97 and 1997/98.

He has gone onto be a part of 4 more Saturday Pennant Premiership teams in 2007/08, 2012/13, 2014/15 and of course in our club's most successful season 2024/25.

In 2019/2000, men were able to play Midweek Pennant.

Trevor has been a part of our club's incredible run of Premierships since that season, playing in every Grand Final, winning 5 out of 6. Including 2021/22, 2022/23, 2023/24 and 2024/25.

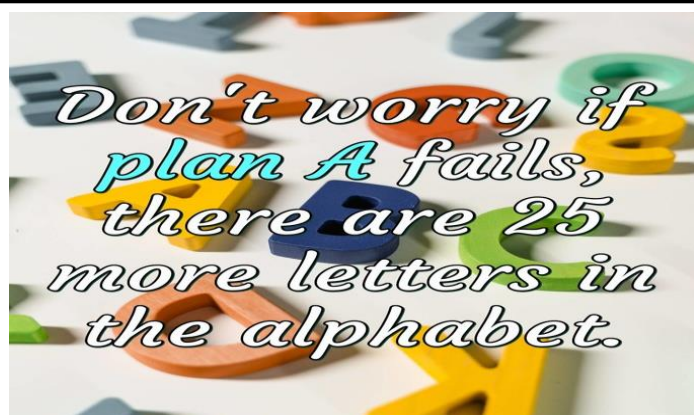

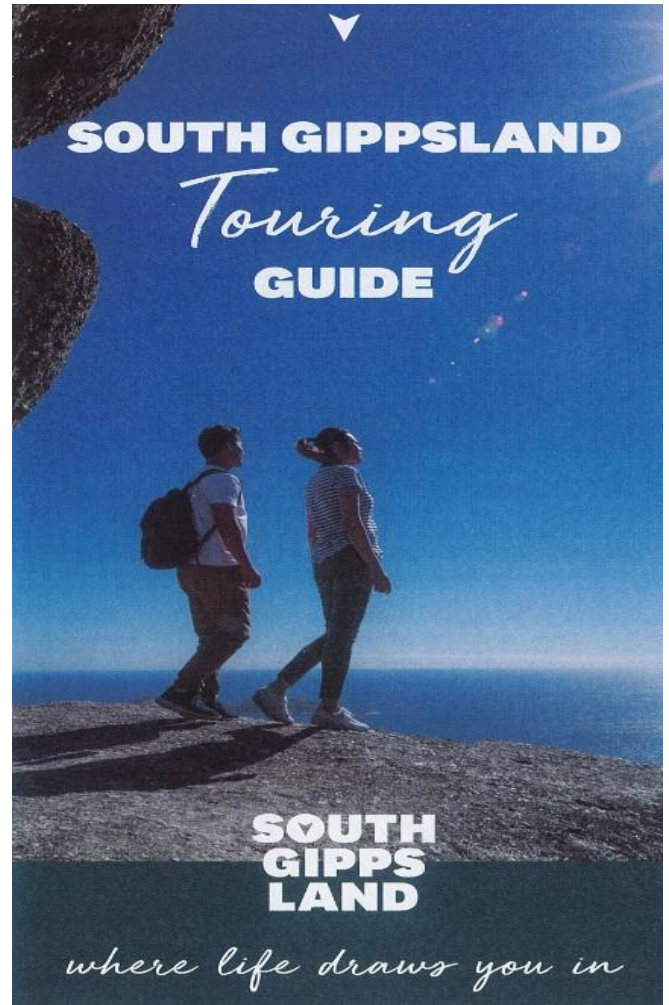
